Awards not accepted:

- 1) "Best Choreography Award" from vsCD Toneelprijzen in Maastricht (1993)
as this award put me in direct competition with my older colleague Hans van Manen.
I do not regard art as a competitive occupation so consequently I will never contribute to rivalry amongst artists.
- 2) "Swan Dance Award" in Maastricht (2009)
As this award was given to me, I have passed it on directly to Gerald Tibbs.
Gerald was one of the most important dancers of NDT since 1975.
He became the artistic director of NDT II in 1990.
- 3) "Deutscher Tanzpreis" (2010)
After several meetings with the people at the core of the decision making committee of the "Deutscher Tanzpreis", I felt that I was not the right person to receive this award.
